

BT11: Consultancy Services



Disability Awareness Training

Bendrigg Trust has been delivering disability awareness courses for many years. The training is designed to increase confidence in working with people with a disability and the delivery of inclusive activities.

£75 per person + VAT to include lunch (suitable for individual instructors or small groups)

Climbing for All

This course is activity specific and includes adaptations and techniques developed over many years by the Trust to enable and support inclusive climbing and abseiling for people with disabilities. MTA members gain CPD points for this course.

British Canoeing: Foundation Paddle-Ability Module

This three hour course is a classroom based introduction to disability awareness in a Paddlesport setting. It is aimed at Coaches and Volunteers who are new to working with disabled paddlers. This module will educate attendees on a range of subjects and offer an opportunity for discussion on the thoughts and experiences with other delegates.

£45 per person + VAT to include lunch – minimum group size 5 people

British Canoeing: Intermediate Paddle-Ability Module

This is a full day classroom and practical course that develops the ideas from the Foundation Module. It is aimed at coaches wishing to develop their knowledge of adaptive equipment and coaching principles. This Module will include opportunities for delegates to consider and discuss different communication and coaching techniques that can be used when working with people with a range of disabilities, an opportunity to try out some of the adaptive equipment available and learn about the considerations that may need to be applied when planning a programme of activity for disabled paddlers.

Moving and Assisting People in the Outdoor Environment

The aim of the course is to train delegates in the current and best practice when moving and assisting people in the outdoor environment.
