Facilities

It should be noted that there are no shops nearby, so guests should bring everything with them that they are likely to need during their stay. However, we do have a small tuck shop on-site selling a selection of sweets, drinks, postcards, souvenirs and a limited selection of toiletries. Laundry facilities are available for emergency use only. Mobile phone reception is limited but there is a payphone in the main Lodge. The number is 01539 733873.
