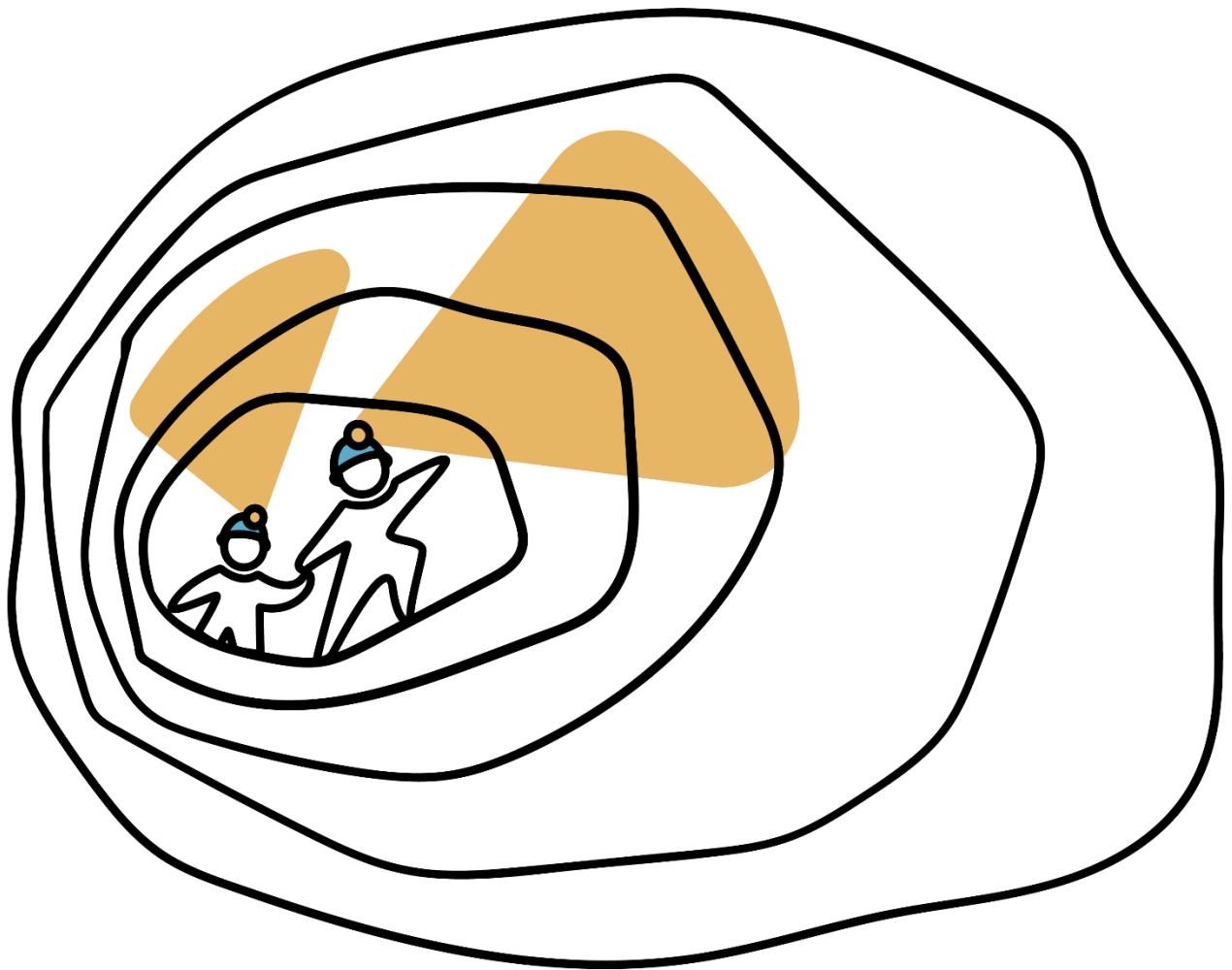




Caving

When we arrive we will get off the transport and put on our caving belts and helmets.



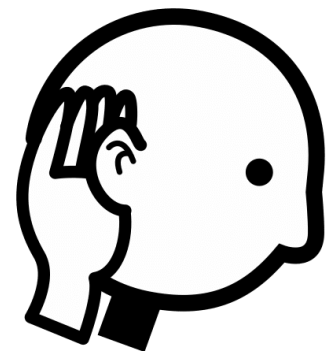
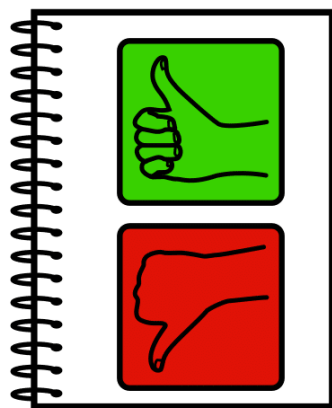
We will walk from the transport into the cave.

I will go back to Bendrigg on the bus or in the car.



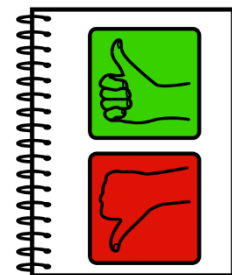
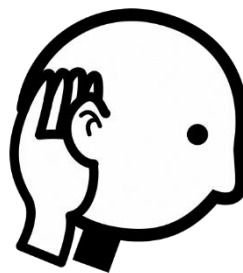
I may feel excited.
