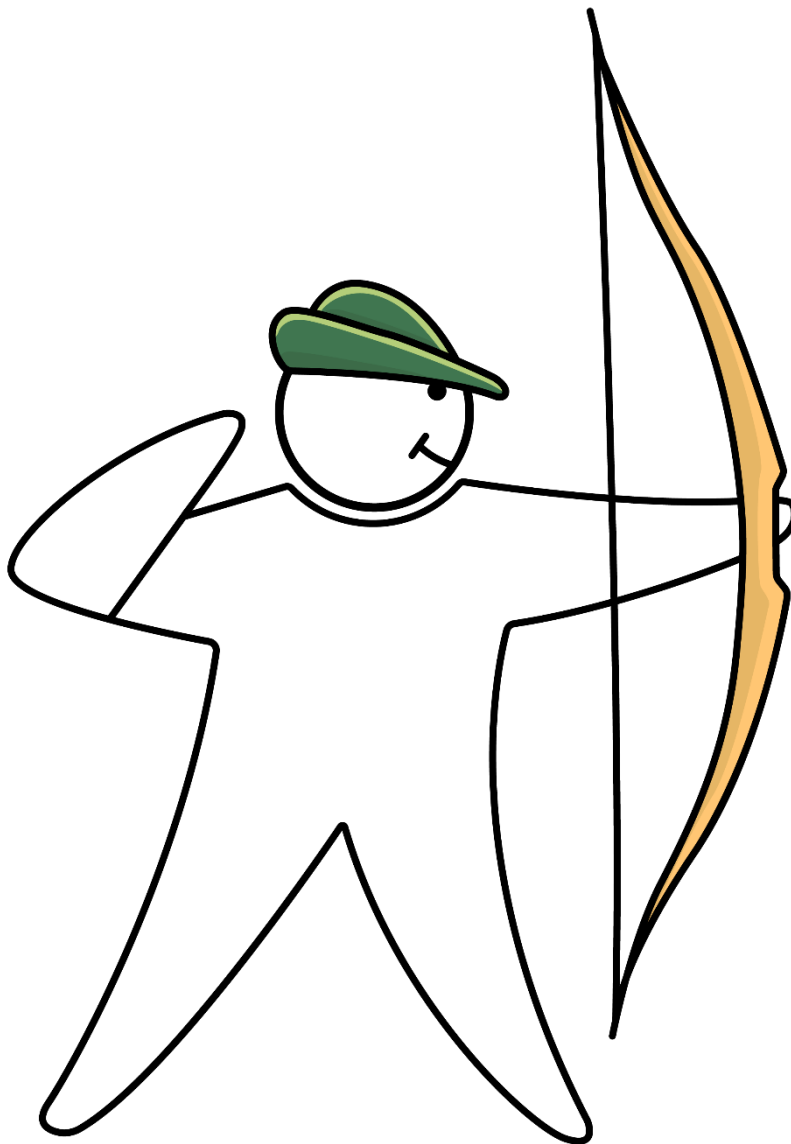




Outdoor Archery

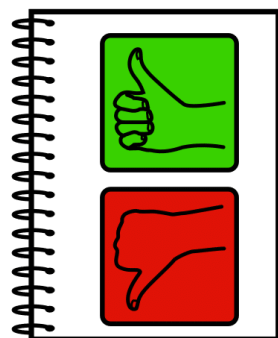


I am doing Archery.

I will go to the Archery shed on the bottom field.



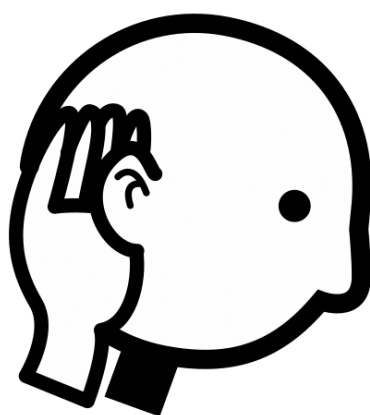
I will meet the Bendrigg tutor and other people. They will talk to me about the rules.

The Bendrigg Tutor may help me if I need it.



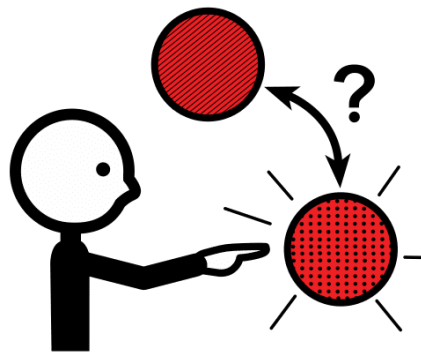
When everyone has finished firing arrows, we will count them up. I may be asked to help collect the arrows. I must walk and never run.



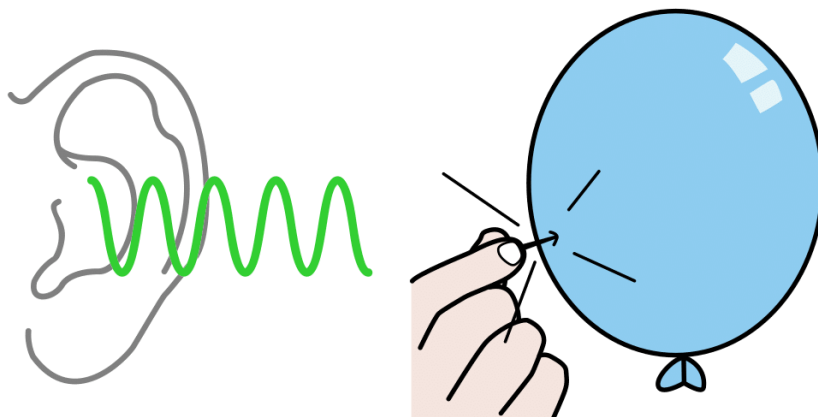
Sometimes I may be asked if I would like to try to pop balloons.

When I have finished my turn, I will sit and wait.

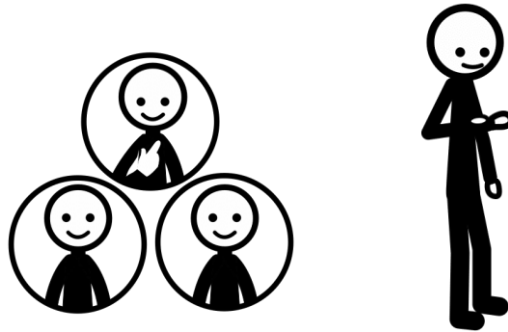


I may feel excited.



I may be able to have another go.

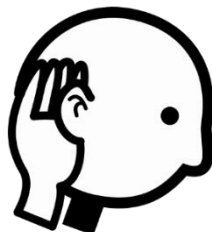
I will need to wait my turn.
